3. What is the name of the disease caused by changes in the retina? Diabetic Retinopathy
4. Hardening and narrowing of the arteries can lead coronary artery disease and stroke.
5. Adults with diabetes are two to three times more likely than people without diabetes to die of heart disease.
6. Chronic kidney disease is a change in the kidney that reduces kidney function and leads to kidney failure.
7. Nerve damage in the feet, along with poor blood flow due to vascular changes, increases the risk of foot complications.
