## Worksheet Guide:

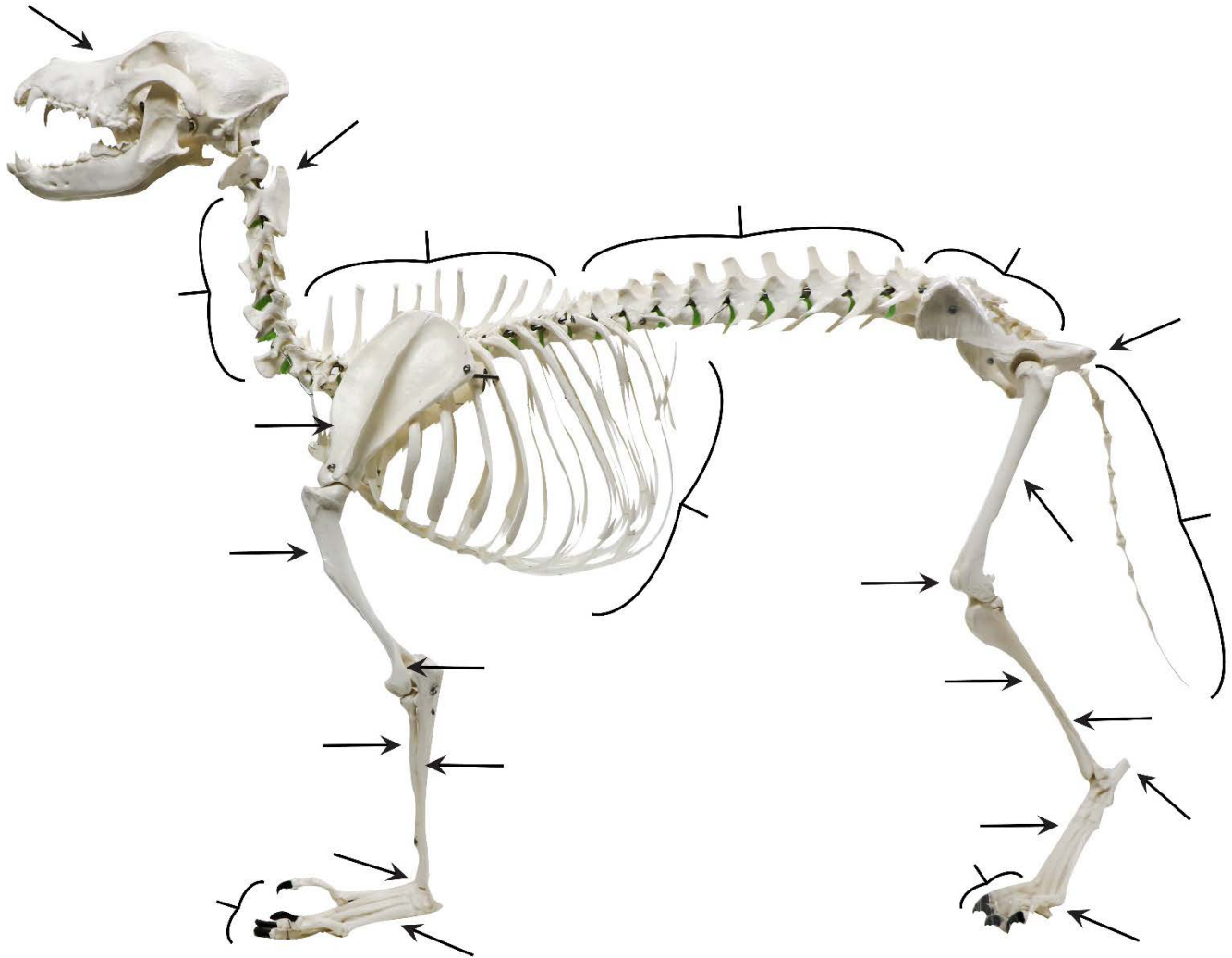
